Across 1 inspection since 2026, the issues cited most often were Plastic Bags, Materials That Could Be Torn Apart and Toy Parts Small Enough to Be Swallowed Were Accessible to Children Under Three Years of Age. (1), Prohibited Styrofoam and Foam Rubber Products Were Accessible to Children Under 3 Years of Age And/or Approved Foam Products Were Used Without Proper... (1), and All Staff Did Not Successfully Complete Certification in First Aid Appropriate to the Age of Children in Care. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **Plastic Bags, Materials That Could Be Torn Apart and Toy Parts Small Enough to Be Swallowed Were Accessible to Children Under Three Years of Age.**

In space #3 (one year old children), a drawer that that was lower than five (5) feet contained plastic bags. Violation confirmed corrected

● **Prohibited Styrofoam and Foam Rubber Products Were Accessible to Children Under 3 Years of Age And/or Approved Foam Products Were Used Without Proper...**

supervision. A vinyl rug in space #6 was torn in places and the children in this classroom are two years old. Violation confirmed corrected

● **All Staff Did Not Successfully Complete Certification in First Aid Appropriate to the Age of Children in Care.**

Verification of staff completion of First Aid training from an approved training organization was not in the staff file. Two teachers could not find their certificate for first aid

● **All Staff Did Not Successfully Complete Certification in CPR Training Appropriate to the Age of the Children in Care.**

Verification of staff completion of the CPR course from an approved training organization was not in the staff file. Two teachers could not find their certificate for CPR
