(1), The Medical Action Plan Was Not Updated on an Annual Basis or When Changes to the Plan Were Made by the Child's Parent or Health Care Professional. (1), and Child Was Handled Roughly. (1). None of the 4 findings were critical.

● **All Equipment and Furnishings Were Not in Good Repair.**

Two wooden swings located on the playground used for the toddlers and two-year-old children had peeling paint and splinters. These swings were blocked off today, so children could not use them. Violation corrected during visit

Two children's action plans were on the WCPSS form and did not have the required information. The forms were missing what signs the child

● **Child Was Handled Roughly.**

On March 4, 2024 a staff member grabbed and pulled a five-year-old child by the arm. On another occasion, the staff member grabbed, pulled, and pushed the child causing the child to fall to the floor. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from pro
