Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Children Were Not Adequately Supervised at All Times. (1), Center Staff Did Not Comply with the Safe Sleep Policy. (1), and Caregivers Did Not Document Compliance with Visually Checking on Sleeping Infants Aged 12 Months or Younger And/or the Documents Were Not Maintained for A... (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **Children Were Not Adequately Supervised at All Times.**

On 1/15/2026, two children ages 3 and 4, were not supervised in their classroom. Staff members were not aware of inappropriate activities between children. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 2/9/2026

Nov 18, 2025 4 Findings ● 4 Important

● **Center Staff Did Not Comply with the Safe Sleep Policy.**

The facility policy states that the "rollover" statements will be on the crib and in the children's file. A review of the children's file did not produce the statements. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from pro

● **Caregivers Did Not Document Compliance with Visually Checking on Sleeping Infants Aged 12 Months or Younger And/or the Documents Were Not Maintained for A...**

minimum of one month. On the video reviewed a staff member placed a child in the crib for over thirty minutes and did not document

● **Screen Time Was Offered to Children Under Three Years of Age.**

Three (3) children under twenty-four months were observed participating in a screentime activity for approximately thirty-five (35) minutes. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 11/20/2025
