Operator did not submit the original approved report to DCDEE within one week of the inspection visit on a form provided by the Division The fire inspection was approximately a month
- **A Safe Indoor and Outdoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children.**
Part of the fence around the playground was replaced and completed on 3/2/36. The latches on the gates going out to the road are one push action and would be easy for a child to get out. Violation confirmed corre
- **Parent's Medication Authorization Did Not Include Required Information.**
A tube of Aquaphor did not have any type of permission from the parent with it. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 3/13/2026
