(1), and For Children Under Three Years of Age, Developmentally Appropriate Toys and Activities Were Not Provided as Outlined in Rule. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **Outdoor Area Was Not Designed So Staff Are Able to Adequately Supervise the Entire Area.**

The preschool playground had several tall plants that obstructs the view for staff to adequately supervise the children. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 8/27/202

● **For Children Under Three Years of Age, Developmentally Appropriate Toys and Activities Were Not Provided as Outlined in Rule.**

The infant and toddlers classrooms need to add fine motor, sensory, pretend play and blocks materials to their classrooms. Violation confirmed corrected by le
