● **Children Between 12 and 24 Months of Age Were Grouped with Children 3 Years of Age or Older.**

There was a nine-year-old being cared for in the classroom with children ages one-through-two years of age. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 5/27/2026

● **All Beds, Cots, or Mats with Individual Linen Were Not Provided for Each Child.**

The majority of the children did not have linens for their cots during nap time. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 5/27/2026

● **Prior to Employment a Criminal Background Check Was Not Completed.**

During today's visit it was noted that one (1) new staff member did not have a Criminal Background Check prior to employment. Violation confirmed corrected by follow-up visit made by consultant on 5/27/2026

● **Children's Records Were Not Made Available for Review.**

The nine-year-old child present during my visit did not have a file available for review. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 5/27/2026

● **A Valid Qualification Letter Was Not on File and Available to Review at the Facility.**

During my visit today there were three (3) staff members that did not have a valid qualification letter. One staff member's qualification letter expired on 01/22/2026. One staff member's qualificatio
