(1), All Staff Did Not Successfully Complete Certification in CPR Training Appropriate to the Age of the Children in Care. (1), and A Current Activity Plan Was Not Posted for Each Group of Children for Reference. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

- **All Staff Did Not Successfully Complete Certification in First Aid Appropriate to the Age of Children in Care.**

Verification of staff completion of First Aid training from an approved training organization was not in the staff file. Documentation was not on file for two staff members.

- **All Staff Did Not Successfully Complete Certification in CPR Training Appropriate to the Age of the Children in Care.**

Verification of staff completion of the CPR course from an approved training organization was not in the staff file. Documentation was not on file for one staff member

Dec 10, 2025 3 Findings ● 3 Important

- **A Current Activity Plan Was Not Posted for Each Group of Children for Reference.**

In space #3, the activity plan was dated Oct. 27 - Oct. 31. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 12/15/2025

- **All Corrosive Agents, Pesticides, Bleaches, Detergents, Cleansers, Polishes, Any Product Which Is Under Pressure in an Aerosol Dispenser, and Any Substance...**
