(1), and Potentially Hazardous Items Such as Archery Equipment, Hand and Power Tools, Nails, Chemicals, or Propane Stoves, Were Not Stored in Locked Areas or with Other... (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

The top of the fence, less than six feet, was not free from protrusions. There were eight exposed nails on the wooden fence to the right of the playground. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received

● **Emergency Medical Care Information Was Not on File in the Center on the Child's First Day of Attendance And/or Was Not Updated as Changes Occurred or at Least...**
