Across 3 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Medications Including Prescription and Non-prescription Items Were Not Stored in a Locked Cabinet or Other Locked Container. (1), Staff Did Not Complete the Health and Safety Training Within One Year of Employment. (1), and All Walls and Ceilings Including Doors and Windows Were Not Kept Clean, Free of Visible Fungal Growth, and in Good Repair. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

Teachers TX, GZ, SV, VW, JC, CM did not complete their health and safety training within one year of employment. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 1/2/2026

● **All Walls and Ceilings Including Doors and Windows Were Not Kept Clean, Free of Visible Fungal Growth, and in Good Repair.**

A wall thermostat cover fell off the wall and the wall now has exposed wires. This was corrected during the visit by replacing the cover. Violation corrected duri
