None of the 5 findings were critical.

In space 4 there was a feeding plan without a parent signature and date. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 6/10/2024

- **A Drug or Medication Was Administered Without Written Authorization And/or Instructions From a Child's Parent or Authorized Health Professional.**

In space 9 a child did not have a permission to administer medication form on file for their diaper cream. Violation confirmed corrected by

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
