Across 2 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were A Safe Indoor and Outdoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children. (2), Menus for All Meals and Snacks Were Not Current or Posted Where Easily Seen by Parents and Cook. (1), and All Stationary Equipment, More Than 18 Inches High, Was Not Installed Over Protective Surfacing. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

- **Menus for All Meals and Snacks Were Not Current or Posted Where Easily Seen by Parents and Cook.**
There was no menu for the week posted in the classroom. Violation corrected during visit

- **A Safe Indoor and Outdoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children.**
A gallon size plastic storage bag was in the art activity center within reach of children. Violation corrected during visit

Corrected at visit

Sep 7, 2023 3 Findings ● 3 Important

- **All Stationary Equipment, More Than 18 Inches High, Was Not Installed Over Protective Surfacing.**
Rubber mulch in fall zones of equipment measured two inches or less instead of the required 6 inches. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 9/20/2023

- **A Safe Indoor and Outdoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children.**
Nails were protruding out of the bottom of the storage building in the fenced play area accessible to the children. Also on the storage building was chipped wood with very sharp edges also accessible to childre
