(1), and All Walls and Ceilings Including Doors and Windows Were Not Kept Clean, Free of Visible Fungal Growth, and in Good Repair. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **All Floors and Floor Coverings Were Not Constructed of Nonabsorbent Material And/or Were Not Kept Clean and in Good Repair.**

In Space 2 there was a broken tile which created a hole and had exposed flooring underneath. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 4/

● **All Walls and Ceilings Including Doors and Windows Were Not Kept Clean, Free of Visible Fungal Growth, and in Good Repair.**

In Space 2 there is chipping paint on the window sills and is accessible to children. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 4/8/2026

● **Electrical Outlets and Power Strips, Not in Use, Which Were Located in Space Used by Children Did Not Have Safety Outlets or Were Not Covered with Safety Plugs...**
