Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were A Safe Indoor and Outdoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children. (1), A First Aid Information Sheet Was Not Posted in a Place for Referral And/or the Information Sheet Did Not Include All the Required Information. (1), and There Was a Substantiation of Child Maltreatment. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **A Safe Indoor and Outdoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children.**

A staff member served hot mashed potatoes to a 14-month-old child, burning the inside and outside of the child's mouth area, resulting in 2nd degree burns. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from pr

● **A First Aid Information Sheet Was Not Posted in a Place for Referral And/or the Information Sheet Did Not Include All the Required Information.**

The staff member did not utilize the first aid poster in the classroom when the staff member applied Aquaphor to the burned area of the child

● **There Was a Substantiation of Child Maltreatment.**

Pursuant to its investigation, the Division has confirmed sufficient information to determine child maltreatment. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 2/18/2026

Oct 27, 2025 2 Findings ● 2 Important

● **All Staff Did Not Wash Their Hands Thoroughly After Diapering Each Child.**

Staff members in Space Infant A and Toddler A did not wash their hands after diapering with children. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 10/29/2025

● **A Child's Hands Were Not Washed After Each Diaper Change.**

Several children's hands were not washed after diaper change in spaces Infant A and Toddler A. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 10/29/2025
