Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Items Used for Starting Fires, Such as Matches, Accelerants, and Lighters, Were Not Kept in Locked Storage. (1), Electrical Outlets Not in Use Were Not Covered. (1), and Appliances with Heating Elements, Such as Bottle Warmers, Crock Pots, Curling Irons, and Electrical Cords Were Accessible to Children. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **Items Used for Starting Fires, Such as Matches, Accelerants, and Lighters, Were Not Kept in Locked Storage.**

During today's visit while transitioning from the kitchen to the living room of the home a candle was observed lit and being stored on the counter space near the kitchen sink.

● **Electrical Outlets Not in Use Were Not Covered.**

While conducting the walkthrough five (5) electrical outlets were observed uncovered when not in use, four (4) in the kitchen and one (1) in the licensed childcare space. Violation corrected during visit

● **Appliances with Heating Elements, Such as Bottle Warmers, Crock Pots, Curling Irons, and Electrical Cords Were Accessible to Children.**

While monitoring the licensed childcare space a string of decorative lights was observed hung around the top border of the wall with the end piece of
