(1), and Each Staff Member Did Not Have the Required Medical Report, Proof of Tuberculosis Test or Screening And/or Completed Health Questionnaire in a Medical File,... (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

In space one hundred and twenty two (122) the gross motor activity was not posted on the activity plan. Violation corrected during visit

One child's folder showed a medical exam form completed more than thirty (30) days past the enrollment date. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 12/16/2024

● **Each Staff Member Did Not Have the Required Medical Report, Proof of Tuberculosis Test or Screening And/or Completed Health Questionnaire in a Medical File,...**

● **Food Required for Any Special Diet Was Not Provided by Parent or Center.**

On June 12, 2024, a three-year-old child with a severe food allergy was not served food in alignment with his dietary needs. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 6/21/2024
