Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Medications Including Prescription and Non-prescription Items Were Not Stored in a Locked Cabinet or Other Locked Container. (1), Emergency Medical Care Information Was Not on File in the Center on the Child's First Day of Attendance And/or Was Not Updated as Changes Occurred or at Least... (1), and Emergency Information Did Not Name Child's Health Care Professional. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **Medications Including Prescription and Non-prescription Items Were Not Stored in a Locked Cabinet or Other Locked Container.**

One (1) bottle of acetaminophen was stored in an unlocked compartment of a backpack that was stored on a shelf five (5) feet above the ground. Violation corrected during visit

● **Emergency Medical Care Information Was Not on File in the Center on the Child's First Day of Attendance And/or Was Not Updated as Changes Occurred or at Least...**

annually for each child. The emergency medical care information for seven (7) children was not updated on an annual basis. Violation corrected during visit

● **Emergency Information Did Not Name Child's Health Care Professional.**

One (1) child's enrollment application did not include the responsible party's choice of health professional. Violation corrected during visit
