Operator did not submit the original approved report to DCDEE within one week of the inspection visit on a form provided by the Division. The center's annual inspection was due no I

● **All Floors and Floor Coverings Were Not Constructed of Nonabsorbent Material And/or Were Not Kept Clean and in Good Repair.**

The kitchen baseboards and flooring were monitored in poor repair or grime/dirt/rust build ups around grease trap and metal sinks. Violation confirmed corrected

● **All Walls and Ceilings Including Doors and Windows Were Not Kept Clean, Free of Visible Fungal Growth, and in Good Repair.**

The kitchen walls, kitchen backsplash, door and cabinets were monitored with many stained, grime and/or food build up or with chipped paint. Violation confirmed

● **Equipment and Furnishings Not Meeting the Requirements Outlined in Child Care .0601(b) and (C) Were Not Removed or Made Inaccessible.**

An area rug in space #7 was monitored with visible stains. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 4/20/2026
