Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Staff Did Not Complete the Health and Safety Training Within One Year of Employment. (2), Equipment and Furnishings Not Meeting the Requirements Outlined in Child Care .0601(b) and (C) Were Not Removed or Made Inaccessible. (1), and All Equipment and Furnishings Were Not in Good Repair. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

There were thirteen(13) pieces of chalk and twenty-one(21) crayons that needed to be replaced. Violation corrected during visit

- **All Equipment and Furnishings Were Not in Good Repair.**

Some of the bottom horizontal poles on the fence were showing signs of rust including five poles on the back, two poles on the right side, and three poles on the left side. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from pr

- **Staff Did Not Complete the Health and Safety Training Within One Year of Employment.**

One substitute staff did not complete the administration of medication training. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 4/20/2026

- **The Child Care Administrator and All Staff Did Not Complete the Recognizing and Responding to Suspensions of Child Maltreatment Training Within 90 Days Of...**
