(1), The EPR Plan Did Not Include the Date of the Last Revision of the Plan. (1), and All Equipment and Furnishings Were Not in Good Repair. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

- **All Equipment and Furnishings Were Not in Good Repair.**

Music bench that is on the toddler play area needs to be sanded and free of hazards from the wood. Wood needs to be sanded down so children will not get splinters from the wood when playing. Violation confirmed corrected by letter
