An outdoor play area inspection had not been completed. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 10/4/2023

● **The EMC Plan Was Not Reviewed with All Staff Annually and Whenever the Plan Was Revised.**

Signed verification of this review were not on file for any of the three staff members. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 10/4/2023

● **All Staff, Including the Director, Did Not Have an Annual Health Questionnaire on File Following the Initial Medical Statement.**
