(1), and The Depth of the Loose Surfacing Was Not Based on Critical Height of the Equipment. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

- **Medical Exam or Health Assessment Record Was Not on File Before or Within 30 Days After Admission.**
One child did not have a health assessment in their file. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 5/19/2026
- **Each Child Was Not Immunized as per Article 6 of Chapter 130A and an Immunization Record Was Not on File Before or Within 30 Days After Admission.**
One child did not have an immunization record in their file. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 5/19/2026
- **The Depth of the Loose Surfacing Was Not Based on Critical Height of the Equipment.**
More mulch is needed under the slides and around the swing fall zones. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 6/2/2026

- **Parent's Medication Authorization Did Not Include Required Information.**
In the two year old classroom the parent's medical authorization to apply diaper creams had expired. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 10/29/2025
