Across 4 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Incident Logs Were Not Completed and Maintained as Required. (2), A Safe Indoor and Outdoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children. (1), and The Center Did Not Comply with the Permit Restrictions. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

A 17 month old child with a egg allergy was given a cupcake at snack. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 4/13/2026

● **Incident Logs Were Not Completed and Maintained as Required.**

I observed one incident report dated December 5, 2025, that had not been documented on the incident log. Violation corrected during visit

Dec 2, 2025 2 Findings ● 2 Important

● **The Center Did Not Comply with the Permit Restrictions.**

The facility follows enhanced space which is indicated on the permit posted. The space capacity of playground 3 allows 14 children at 100 square feet. On November 14, 2025, at 3:55pm there were 18 children on the playground. Vio

● **Incident Logs Were Not Completed and Maintained as Required.**

An incident reported completed on November 14, 2025, for a one year old child was not logged. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 12/9/2025
