Children's special diets or food allergies were not posted where they can be seen in the food preparation area and in the child's eating area. Violation confirmed corre

● **Refrigerator(s) Did Not Maintain a Temperature of 45 Degrees F. or Below.**

The refrigerator used to store beverages did not have a thermometer indicating the temperature. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 8/4/2025

● **Electrical Outlets and Power Strips, Not in Use, Which Were Located in Space Used by Children Did Not Have Safety Outlets or Were Not Covered with Safety Plugs...**
