One child's hands were not washed after having a soiled diaper changed. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 4/14/2025

● **A Current Activity Plan Was Not Posted for Each Group of Children for Reference.**

Posted activity plans in three classrooms were not current. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 4/14/2025
