In space #3, written authorization for a tube of A&D ointment was not available for review. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received

● **A Drug or Medicine Was Administered After Its Expiration Date. .**

In space #3, a tube of A&D ointment expired on September 2024. Violation corrected during visit
