(1), and A Child Was Handled in a Rough Way, Including Shaking, Pushing, Shoving, Pinching, Slapping, Biting, Kicking, or Spanking. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

A child was fed a food that contained red dye. On the application, the parent documented the child was allergic to red dye. Violation confirmed

Dec 30, 2025 1 Finding ● 1 Important

- **All Corrosive Agents, Pesticides, Bleaches, Detergents, Cleansers, Polishes, Any Product Which Is Under Pressure in an Aerosol Dispenser, and Any Substance...**
