(1), Daily Records of Arrival and Departure Times for Children at the Center Were Not Maintained as Children Arrive and Depart And/or Were Not Made Available For... (1), and A Current Activity Plan Was Not Posted for Each Group of Children for Reference. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

In space #3 where children ages 1 and 2 receive care, an activity plan was not posted and available for reference. This is a repeat violation cited on January 20, 2026. Violation confirmed corrected by le

● **All Stationary Equipment, More Than 18 Inches High, Was Not Installed Over Protective Surfacing.**

In the outdoor play area, there were five (5) Little Tykes climbing structures that measured more than 18 inches high and were not installed over protective surfacing. Violation confirmed
