Across 4 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Enhanced Staff/child Ratios and Group Sizes Were Not Met. (1), Health and Safety Training Topics Were Not Included as Part of On-going Training Within Five Years of Completing the Previous Health and Safety Training Topics. (1), and Each New Employee Did Not Complete, Within the First Two Weeks of Employment, Six Clock Hours of Training in Required Topic Areas. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
