(1), and All Corrosive Agents, Pesticides, Bleaches, Detergents, Cleansers, Polishes, Any Product Which Is Under Pressure in an Aerosol Dispenser, and Any Substance... (1). None of the 4 findings were critical.

The wooden border around the stationary outdoor climber was cracked, splintered and several nails were sticking up and could be a tripping hazard. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on

Mar 10, 2025 1 Finding ● 1 Important

● **All Stationary Equipment, More Than 18 Inches High, Was Not Installed Over Protective Surfacing.**

The stationary piece of equipment did not have at least six inches of mulch surfacing in front of the slide or steps out six feet and six feet around the rest of the structure. Violation

● **All Corrosive Agents, Pesticides, Bleaches, Detergents, Cleansers, Polishes, Any Product Which Is Under Pressure in an Aerosol Dispenser, and Any Substance...**
