In space 102, a diaper cream parent permission form did not include expiration date of cream and description of how to apply the cream. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 2/19/2026

● **Plastic Bags, Materials That Could Be Torn Apart and Toy Parts Small Enough to Be Swallowed Were Accessible to Children Under Three Years of Age.**

In space 101, wipes stored in soft plastic labeled "keep out of reach of children" were observed stored on top of a shelf in the bathroom,

● **Shelter-in-place or Lockdown Drills Were Not Practiced Every Three Months And/or Drill Record Was Incomplete. the Last Quarterly Drill Was Practiced On...**
