Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were All Walls and Ceilings Including Doors and Windows Were Not Kept Clean, Free of Visible Fungal Growth, and in Good Repair. (2), Toys and Other Mouth-contact Surfaces Were Not Cleaned and Sanitized Daily When Used or Cleaned More Frequently if Visibly Dirty. (1), and A Drug or Medicine Was Administered After Its Expiration Date. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **Toys and Other Mouth-contact Surfaces Were Not Cleaned and Sanitized Daily When Used or Cleaned More Frequently if Visibly Dirty.**

Dolls, bibs and other surfaces were observed to have visible fungal growth. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 8/20/2025

● **All Walls and Ceilings Including Doors and Windows Were Not Kept Clean, Free of Visible Fungal Growth, and in Good Repair.**

In the bathroom connected to Space 2 there was visible fungal growth on the wall and ceiling. Prior to cleaning, visible fungal growth was also observed by teachi

● **All Walls and Ceilings Including Doors and Windows Were Not Kept Clean, Free of Visible Fungal Growth, and in Good Repair.**

In Spaces 4 and 6 there were areas of peeling paint with drywall exposed and various areas with crayon/marker scribbles on the walls. Violation confirmed correcte

● **A Drug or Medicine Was Administered After Its Expiration Date.**

In Spaces 7 and 9 there were over the counter creams/ointments which had expired. Violation corrected during visit
