During the visit, I observed a base board that was separated from the wall in space 807 exposing a damaged wall that was accessible to infants. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 6/

● **Medications Including Prescription and Non-prescription Items Were Not Stored in a Locked Cabinet or Other Locked Container.**

During the visit, I observed one (1) tube of Nystatin in space four (4) in an unlocked box stored on a shelf over five (5) vertical feet. Violation corrected du

● **Prescribed Medicine Was Not in Original Labeled Container or Accompanied by Signed and Dated Written Instructions From Prescribing Physician or Health Care...**

● **All Staff Did Not Successfully Complete Certification in First Aid Appropriate to the Age of Children in Care.**
