In classroom #3 a current activity plan was not posted. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 4/21/2026
- **Any Excess Formula, Thawed Human Milk And/or Bottled Beverage Were Not Discarded or Returned Home at the End of Each Day.**
In classroom #1 a bottle that contained formula and dated April 2 was not discarded at the end of the day. This was discarded during the visit so, it was correct
- **All Walls and Ceilings Including Doors and Windows Were Not Kept Clean, Free of Visible Fungal Growth, and in Good Repair.**
In the staff bathroom there was an area of the wall behind the sink that was not in good repair. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider o
