Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were All Stationary Equipment, More Than 18 Inches High, Was Not Installed Over Protective Surfacing. (1), Food Substitution Was Not Recorded on the Menu Prior to the Meal or Snack Being Served. (1), and The Depth of the Loose Surfacing Was Not Based on Critical Height of the Equipment. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **All Stationary Equipment, More Than 18 Inches High, Was Not Installed Over Protective Surfacing.**

Stationary equipment did not have adequate surfacing and grass was observed growing in the surfacing provided. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 12/17/2025

Mar 25, 2025 2 Findings ● 2 Important

● **Food Substitution Was Not Recorded on the Menu Prior to the Meal or Snack Being Served.**

Menu stated applesauce cup would be served for lunch but pears were served. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 4/8/2025

● **The Depth of the Loose Surfacing Was Not Based on Critical Height of the Equipment.**

Mulch needs to be added to the area where all the stationary equipment is located. The need for mulch was recorded and requester per completed outdoor inspection forms. Violation confirmed corrected by

● **Fire Drills Were Not Practiced Monthly And/or the Drill Record Was Incomplete.**

A fire drill was not recorded for November 2024. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 12/16/2024
