Space #22 is an unlicensed space that was being used today to gather children at arrival time, sign children in for the day and to get attendance. This space has not been measured and/or approved by DCDEE to care for children. Violation confi

● **A Current Activity Plan Was Not Posted for Each Group of Children for Reference.**

In classroom space #2, the posted activity plan was not current and was dated November 3-7, 2025. Violation corrected during visit
