Across 3 inspections since 2026, the issues cited most often were Incident Reports Were Not Completed Each Time a Child Was Injured, It Did Not Include All the Information Required in Rule, It Was Not Signed by the Parent... (1), A Child Care Operator Did Not Notify the Division of Any New Child Care Providers, as Defined in G.S. 110-90.2(a)(2), Who Were Hired or Moved Into the Child... (1), and There Were No Clean Clothes Available for the Children to Wear When Children's Clothes Became Wet or Soiled. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

Clean clothes were not available for one (1) child whose clothes became wet. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 2/2/2026

● **Each Child Was Not Attended to in a Nurturing and Appropriate Manner, or in Keeping with the Child's Developmental Needs.**

A three (3) year old child was taken outside on 1/8/26 in a t-shirt, underwear, and a jacket. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 2/
