Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Children Were Not Adequately Supervised at All Times. (1), Incident Reports Were Not Completed Each Time a Child Was Injured, It Did Not Include All the Information Required in Rule, It Was Not Signed by the Parent... (1), and Parent's Medication Authorization Did Not Include Required Information. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

Jun 2, 2026 2 Findings ● 2 Important

● **Children Were Not Adequately Supervised at All Times.**

One staff was not aware of two children's activities inside of a play structure which resulted in an injury. Violation confirmed corrected by follow-up visit made by consultant on 6/2/2026

● **Incident Reports Were Not Completed Each Time a Child Was Injured, It Did Not Include All the Information Required in Rule, It Was Not Signed by the Parent...**

and/or it was not maintained in the child's file. An incident report for an injury which occurred on May 20, 2026 was not on file

Dec 3, 2025 3 Findings ● 3 Important

● **Parent's Medication Authorization Did Not Include Required Information.**

In Space 10 permission to administer forms did not include all required information. Violation corrected during visit

Corrected at visit

● **Leftover Medicines Were Not Returned to the Parent After the Course of Treatment Was Completed, After Authorization Was Withdrawn or After Authorization Had...**

expired and/or medication was not discarded within 72 hours of completion of treatment or withdrawal of authorization. A prescri

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● **Shelter-in-place or Lockdown Drills Were Not Practiced Every Three Months And/or Drill Record Was Incomplete.**

The last emergency drill was conducted on July 9, 2025. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 12/16/2025

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
