Playground inspection forms from October 2022 through December 2022 and January 2023 through April 2023 were not documented and available for r

- **Application for Enrollment Did Not Include All Required Information.**

One child enrolled on August 28, 2023, is missing information in the health care needs section on their application. The missing information includes the following: specific health care needs, concerns, and symptoms
