(1), Electrical Outlets and Power Strips, Not in Use, Which Were Located in Space Used by Children Did Not Have Safety Outlets or Were Not Covered with Safety Plugs... (1), and Electric Fans Were Not Mounted Out of Reach or Did Not Have a Mesh Guard to Prevent Access. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
