Across 4 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Shelter-in-place or Lockdown Drills Were Not Practiced Every Three Months And/or Drill Record Was Incomplete. (3), Health and Safety Training Topics Were Not Included as Part of On-going Training Within Five Years of Completing the Previous Health and Safety Training Topics. (1), and Fire Drills Were Not Practiced Monthly And/or the Drill Record Was Incomplete. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

- **Shelter-in-place or Lockdown Drills Were Not Practiced Every Three Months And/or Drill Record Was Incomplete.**

The lockdown drill conducted on 11/3/25 was not recorded on the drill log report. J. Pettiford recorded the drill during this visit. Violation corrected during visit

- **Health and Safety Training Topics Were Not Included as Part of On-going Training Within Five Years of Completing the Previous Health and Safety Training Topics.**

J. Pettiford completed all health and safety training topics in January/February 2021, these topics were not completed again

- **Fire Drills Were Not Practiced Monthly And/or the Drill Record Was Incomplete.**

During this visit it was observed that a fire drill for August 2025 was not documented on the drill record. School personnel provided documentation showing that a fire drill was conducted on 8/28/25. S. W
