Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Operator Did Not Wash His/her Hands Before and After Handling Food and Feeding the Children. (1), Each Child's Hands Were Not Washed Before and After Eating. (1), and Hazardous Cleaning Supplies and Other Items That Might Be Poisonous E.g. Toxic Plants, Were Not Out of Reach or in Locked Storage When Children Were in Care. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
