Across 5 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were Children Were Not Adequately Supervised at All Times. (1), The Trained Staff Did Not Review the EPR Plan Annually or When Information in the Plan Changed to Ensure All Information Was Current. (1), and Each Child Was Not Attended to in a Nurturing and Appropriate Manner, or in Keeping with the Child's Developmental Needs. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

A child was left on the playground for approximately 1-2 minutes without proper supervision. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 4/24/2025

● **The Trained Staff Did Not Review the EPR Plan Annually or When Information in the Plan Changed to Ensure All Information Was Current.**

Upon reviewing the EPR plan it was observed that it was last updated December 2022. This was corrected at inspection when the Administrator updated t

**Jul 24, 2024** 1 Finding ● 1 Important

● **Each Child Was Not Attended to in a Nurturing and Appropriate Manner, or in Keeping with the Child's Developmental Needs.**

On July 17, 2024, a staff member slapped a one-year-old child on their face in response to the child biting another child. Violation confirmed corrected by letter
