- **Hazardous Cleaning Supplies and Other Items That Might Be Poisonous E.g. Toxic Plants, Were Not Out of Reach or in Locked Storage When Children Were in Care.**

Today dish cleaner and other cleaning supplies were located in an unlocked cabinet accessible to children. Violation corrected
