- **Staff Did Not Complete the Health and Safety Training Within One Year of Employment.**

In Spaces 6 and 9, an activity for the current week was not created or posted. The activity plans posted were dated for last week, April 13 through April 17. Violation confirmed corrected by follow-up vis
