Across 2 inspections since 2026, the issues cited most often were Children Were Not Adequately Supervised at All Times. (1), Swings Did Not Have Surfacing That Extends Two Times the Length of the Pivot Point to the Surface Below Beyond the External Limits of the Equipment. (1), and All Equipment and Furnishings Were Not in Good Repair. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

A two year old child was left unattended outside on the playground. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 4/28/2026

Feb 18, 2026 4 Findings ● 4 Important

● **Swings Did Not Have Surfacing That Extends Two Times the Length of the Pivot Point to the Surface Below Beyond the External Limits of the Equipment.**

The swings did not have enough mulch under them to meet this requirement. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider

● **All Equipment and Furnishings Were Not in Good Repair.**

There is a small plastic climber that is bowing in the center and coming apart. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 3/3/2026

● **A Drug or Medication Was Administered Without Written Authorization And/or Instructions From a Child's Parent or Authorized Health Professional.**

A child in the two's did not have a signed permission form to administer Desitin diaper cream. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received
