Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Prescribed Medicine Was Not in Original Labeled Container or Accompanied by Signed and Dated Written Instructions From Prescribing Physician or Health Care... (1), Parent's Medication Authorization Did Not Include Required Information. (1), and During the Required Fire, Lockdown, or Shelter-in-place Drills, the Evacuation Crib or Other Approved Device Was Not Used as Described in the EPR Plan. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **Prescribed Medicine Was Not in Original Labeled Container or Accompanied by Signed and Dated Written Instructions From Prescribing Physician or Health Care...**

professional. Mupirocin Ointment USP 2% for a child in space #1 was not in its original container with a pharmacy label. Violatio

● **Parent's Medication Authorization Did Not Include Required Information.**

The permission form for Nystatin dated 3/5/26 in space #1 did not include the name of the child and the name of the medication. The form was identified to belong to a child based on the staff statement. Violation

● **During the Required Fire, Lockdown, or Shelter-in-place Drills, the Evacuation Crib or Other Approved Device Was Not Used as Described in the EPR Plan.**

The staff members in space #2 stated that they carry non-mobile children upon on-site evacuation drill. No evacuation devices were ob

● **Center Staff Did Not Comply with the Safe Sleep Policy.**

A 12 month old in space #1, the classroom with infant and one year old children, was sleeping with a stuffed shooting star blanket. Violation corrected during visit
