On April 14, 2025, the operator failed to provide adequate supervision, which created an unsafe environment for a one-year-old child and p

- **There Was a Substantiation of Child Maltreatment.**

On May 6, 2025, the Division determined child maltreatment based on the supervision needs of children. Violation confirmed corrected by follow-up visit made by consultant on 7/23/2025

- **Operator Did Not Provide Supervision According the Individual Age, Needs, and Capabilities of Each Child.**

On April 14, 2025, the operator was unaware when a one-year-old child left the fenced in area and walked to the home next door. Violation confirmed corrected by follow-up visit ma
