Across 1 inspection since 2025, the issues cited most often were Operator Has Not Scheduled and Obtained a Fire Inspection Within 12 Months of the Previous Inspection. (1), Electric Fans Were Not Mounted Out of Reach or Did Not Have a Mesh Guard to Prevent Access. (1), and Plastic Bags, Materials That Could Be Torn Apart and Toy Parts Small Enough to Be Swallowed Were Accessible to Children Under Three Years of Age. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

- **Operator Has Not Scheduled and Obtained a Fire Inspection Within 12 Months of the Previous Inspection.**

Operator did not submit the original approved report to DCDEE within one week of the inspection visit on a form provided by the Division. The fire inspection was completed on 7/10

- **Electric Fans Were Not Mounted Out of Reach or Did Not Have a Mesh Guard to Prevent Access.**

There was a plugged in fan in the hallway on the floor that was on and did not have a barrier. Violation corrected during visit

- **Plastic Bags, Materials That Could Be Torn Apart and Toy Parts Small Enough to Be Swallowed Were Accessible to Children Under Three Years of Age.**

Space one used by children one year of age had plastic bags with diapers in an unlocked cabinet that was not at least five feet from the f

- **The EMC Plan Was Not Reviewed with All Staff Annually and Whenever the Plan Was Revised.**

There was documentation for two staff members that the last time the EMC Plan was reviewed was 8/30/24. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 10/23/2025
