Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Enhanced Staff/child Ratios and Group Sizes Were Not Met. (2), The Center Did Not Comply with the Permit Restrictions. (1), and Equipment and Furnishings Were Not Sturdy, Stable and Free of Hazards. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **Enhanced Staff/child Ratios and Group Sizes Were Not Met.**

A staff member left the classroom to use the adult bathroom which was located down the hall leaving one staff member with eighteen children age 4-5 years old. Violation confirmed corrected by follow-up visit made by consultant

Oct 30, 2024 3 Findings ● 3 Important

● **The Center Did Not Comply with the Permit Restrictions.**

Enhanced s staff/child ratios as stated on the license were observed out of compliance during my visit. Violation confirmed corrected by follow-up visit made by consultant on 11/14/2024

● **Equipment and Furnishings Were Not Sturdy, Stable and Free of Hazards.**

The red plastic sink in dramatic play area in classroom #204 was broken and jagged on 2 corners. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 11/4/2024

● **Enhanced Staff/child Ratios and Group Sizes Were Not Met.**

In classroom #206, I observed one staff member leave the room to get lunches for children in the cafeteria leaving one staff member in the classroom with seven (7) four-year old children and eight (8) five-year old children. Vi
