Across 2 inspections since 2026, the issues cited most often were Children Did Not Wash Their Hands Upon Arrival at the Center, After Each Visit to the Toilet, Before Eating, Before and After Water Activity Play, After... (1), Plastic Bags, Materials That Could Be Torn Apart and Toy Parts Small Enough to Be Swallowed Were Accessible to Children Under Three Years of Age. (1), and Bed, Cribs, Playpens, Cots or Mats Were Not Placed at Least 18" Apart or Separated by Partitions When in Use. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

Accessible to two year old children in the outdoor area, plastic drinking cups were torn into small pieces scattered on the ground. The vio

● **Bed, Cribs, Playpens, Cots or Mats Were Not Placed at Least 18" Apart or Separated by Partitions When in Use.**

In space #1a, I observed four (4) children resting on cots that were placed less than 18" apart. The violation was corrected when the administrator placed the four (4) childre
